100 years ago in 1905 the Wright Brothers built a new design – the Wright Flyer 111, which included an important design change. The brothers installed a separate control for the rear rudder instead of linking the rudder to the wing-warping "cradle" as before. Each of the three axes—pitch, roll and yaw—now had its own independent control.



100 years later in 2005 saw the birth of a new flying club in Northern Thailand – now in its 7th year of operation.

This special anniversary dinner will be held in the Clubhouse – fee 300 baht per person for food and entertainment with drinks available for purchase from the Club bar.
